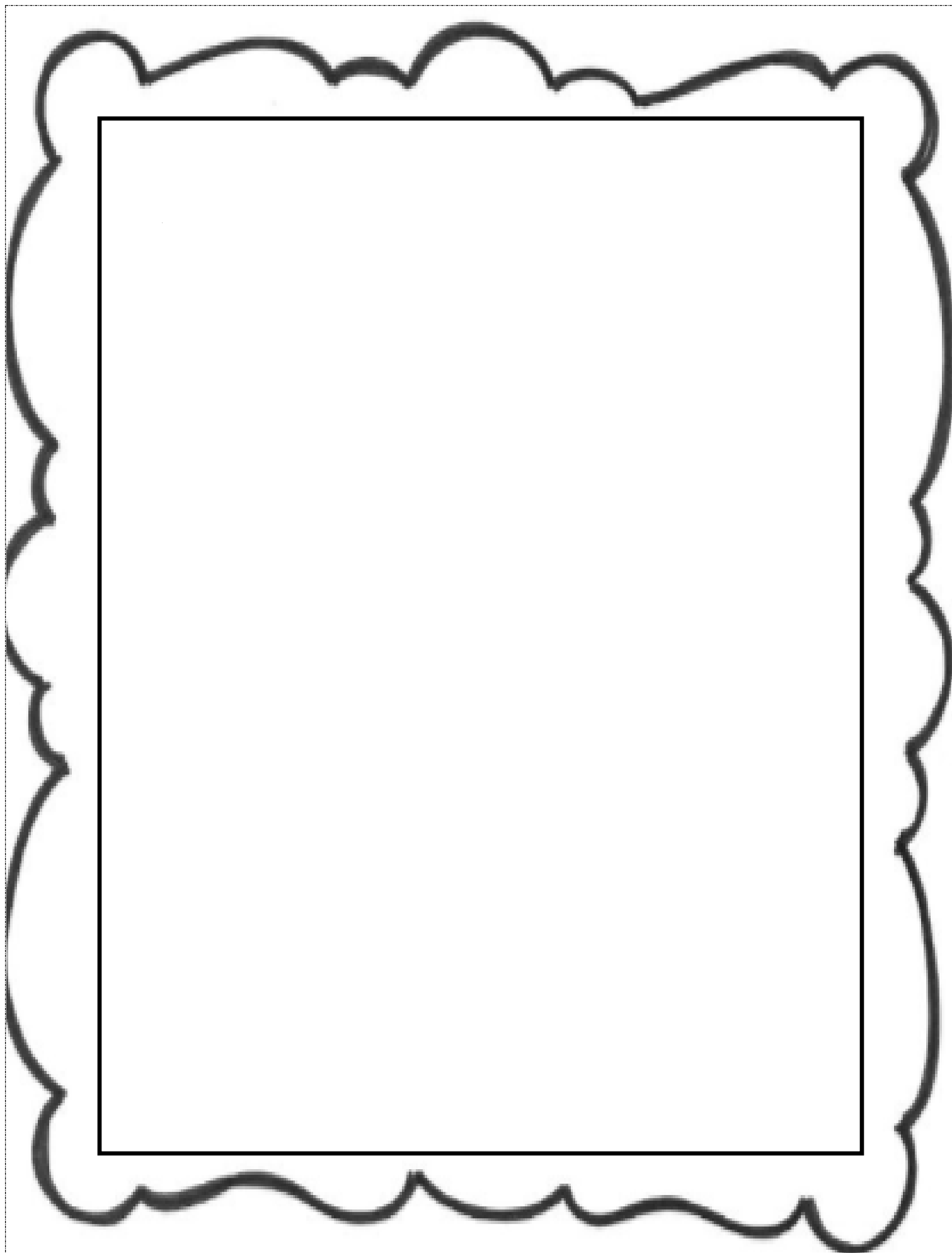
# Which Would You Rather Be?

Read the bios of each math character to better understand the personality of each one and how they live. Then you will write an essay describing your choice of which you’d rather be using the guidelines below. You will then create an illustration using the guidelines to accompany your composition.

## Directions:

1. Your essay must be at least one typed (two written) pages and include the following:
  - a. Why you chose to be that particular math character; with at least four reasons to defend your choice.
  - b. Include three ways that your life will change when you become either the “Factor Ninja” or the “Multiple Monster.”
  - c. Three ways that you will try to change the world by becoming your math character.
  - d. Two ways that you will attempt to conquer the enemy (the math character that you didn’t choose.)
2. Include an illustration of what you will look like as a “Factor Ninja” or “Multiple Monster. The illustration should be:
  - a. Your “ninja” or “monster” should be in full color.
  - b. It should be at least 6”x10”
  - c. It should have three traits that resemble you (hair color, eye color, etc.)
  - d. The figure should be cut out.
